



2019 PINOT NOIR ROSÉ

This wine represents the passing of a torch, the transition of one family's history to another's future. Planted in 2004 by the Zurakowski family, the former Archangel vineyard produces organically farmed single vineyard wines of purity and elegance. Purchased by the Valmorbida family following the 2019 harvest, it is now home to their beloved Nanny Goat Vineyard. The 2019 Pinot Gris was masterfully guided from vineyard to bottle by VinPro winemaker Pete Bartle, who fittingly did the same for the very first vintage of Nanny Goat back in 2005.

Our Rose will grab your attention, not only with its striking colour, but also with its tantalising array of aromas and flavours. Bright Red Berries, Guava, Nectarine and Rose Petal emerge seductively from the glass. The entry to the palate is rich yet delicately balanced, embracing a melange of Raspberry, red plum and Peach fruits. A streak of vibrant acidity lifts the palate to a crisp clean finish.

WINEMAKING

A mix of clones 5, 777 and 113, Hand harvested on the 29th of March 2019. Whole bunch pressed to stainless steel tank for fermentation by yeast selected to retain varietal character. Fermentation was stopped with a little over 5 grams of residual sugar to provide a rich yet perfectly balanced wine.
